- b) It is not "The Revelation of John the Divine"
- c) It has to do with the coming Revelation of Jesus Christ
- d) The Bible teaches two advents of Jesus Christ
 - 1) The 1st advent (coming of Jesus to earth) was not one event, but rather a series of of events.
 - \square The birth of John was the 1st event of the 1st advent
 - ☑ The birth of Jesus an event of the advent
 - \square The life of Jesus an event of the 1st advent
 - ☑ His death, burial, resurrection, ascension events of 1st advent
 - 2) The 2nd advent, like the 1st, is not one event, but like the first will also be a series of events
 - ☑ These events are foretold in scripture.
 - ☑ The rapture (1 Thess. 4:13-18) will be an event of the advent.
 - \square The revelation of Christ will be the 2^{nd} advent.

2. The Book was written by John in A.D. 96

Rev. 1:9-11

a) Thus things that took place at the cross or in A.D. 70 did not fulfill prophecies in Revelation

3. Revelation is a Book of Prophecy

Rev. 1:3

- a) Prophecy is a miracle of utterance and involves foreknowledge. "No one can foretell what one does not know"
- b) Foreknowledge does not belong to men.

c) Foreknowledge does belong to God.

The word, "and", a conjunction, connects the chapters together.

The word, "after" suggests a chronological order.

II. REV 4:1 – "AFTER" CHURCH THINGS

- 1. A door opens in Heaven.
 - a) To let John in!
 - b) Rev. 19:11 All Heaven opens
 - 1) Rev. 19:14 "Armies" come out of Heaven
 - 2) Zech. 14:5 "*All*" the saints

Matt. 25:31 – "All" holy angels

- 2. A voice says "John, come up"
 - a) 1 Cor. 12:28 John is in the invisible church.
 - b) Is John's "going up" a type of 1 Thess. 4:16?

 We believe it is.
 - c) Rev. Chapters Six to Eighteen

John sees all looking down from Heaven!

d) Rev. 2-3 – The Church is on earth

Rev. 4-19 – The Church is in Heaven

III. <u>REV. 4:1 – "*HEAVEN*"</u>

1. Heaven is a real place.

Note Chapter 5:1,7 – Jesus takes the seven-sealed book.

- a) 6:2 Result False Christ
- b) 1 John 2:18 Anti-Christ shall come
- c) In history Many Anti-Christs

Pharaoh – Jew hater

Haman – Jew hater

Herod – Jew hater

Hitler – Jew hater

Arafat – Jew hater

Worst is yet to come!

2. Rev. 6:3 – He breaks the Second Seal

- a) 6:4 Result Peace is taken from earth (cf. 1 Thess. 5:3)
- 3. Rev. 6:5 He breaks the Third Seal
 - a) 6:6 Result Famine (cf. Rev. 7:16)
- 4. Rev. 6:7 He breaks the Fourth Seal
 - a) 6:8 Result 4 sore judgments (Ezekiel 14:21)
- 5. Rev. 6:9 He breaks the Fifth Seal
 - a) 6:10-11 Result Many martyrs to bring judgments later (Rev. 16:5-7)
- 6. Rev. 6:12 He breaks the Sixth Seal

I. Three Groups of Judgments

- 1) Seven Seals Judgments
- 2) Seven Trumpets Judgments
- 3) Seven Vials JudgmentsIn these cups the wrath of God

II. Because These Chapters Are Events Before Christ Returns To Earth, They Must Describe The Tribulation

1) Matthew 24:29-30 (cf. Matt. 24:21)

III. This Tribulation is a Specific Period of Time on Earth

1)	Matthew 24:21 – "Such	as <u>was not</u> "	"Nor <u>ever shall be</u> "	,
	Past	Nothing like	it —	Future

- Segregated from all history, stands out in contrast to this age of grace (cf. Rom. 6:14)
- 2) Jeremiah 30:7 "None is like it"
- 3) Daniel 12:1 "Such as never was"
- 4) Rev. 16:18 "Such as was not"
- 5) Deut. 4:30 "Tribulation...In the latter days"

6) Rev. 6-18 – Terrible events (cf. Heb. 11:7 – "Not seen as yet")

IV. Revelation Chapter Six Describes The Results of the Seal Judgments

- 1) Rev. 6:12 The Sixth Seal
- 2) Rev. 8:1 Opening of the Seventh Seal
- 3) Rev. 7 Therefore is a parenthesis between Seal Six and Seal Seven

V. Revelation Chapter Seven

- 1) Rev. 7:1 After What?
 - Events of six seals
 - "Four corners" (cf. Isa. 11:12)
- 2) Rev. 7:2-3 Introduced to special servants of God
- 3) Rev. 7:4-8 They are all Jews (cf. Romans 11:2-6; 1 Kings 19:18)
- 4) Rev. 7:9,14 After the sealing of the 144,000, multitudes are saved.

VI. Revelation 8:1-2 – The Breaking of the Seventh Seal, Introduces the Judgments of the Trumpets

VII. Because of Matthew 24:15 – Now We Must Look At Daniel 9:24-27 - 70 weeks – 70 sevens

- 1) Note ALL the weeks are upon Daniel's people, upon Daniel's city
- 2) The weeks are divided.
 - a) Verse 25 7 weeks
 - b) Verse 26 62 weeks

After the 7+62 weeks, the Messiah is cut off. See Isa. 53:8. Thus 69 weeks were fulfilled before the cross. Only the 70th remains to be fulfilled after the cross.

- c) Verse $27 1 \text{ week} 70^{\text{th}}$
 - 1. A prince appears.
 - 2. Confirms a covenant for 7 years
 - 3. Sets up an abomination (Matthew 24:15)
 - 4. He does this in the middle of the week.

VIII. Now We Turn To Revelation

- 1) Rev. 11:2 42 months = $3 \frac{1}{2}$ years
- 2) Rev. $11:3 1260 \text{ days} = 3 \frac{1}{2} \text{ years}$
- 3) Rev. 12:6 1260 days = $3\frac{1}{2}$ years
- 4) Rev. 12:14 Time, times, half a time = $3\frac{1}{2}$ years
- 5) Rev. 13.5 42 months = $3\frac{1}{2}$ years

So we learn that the tribulation is divided into two parts of 3 ½ years each.

Rev. 6:2 – False Messiah

2 Thess. 2:11 – The lie (Jesus is the Truth)

Dan. 7:25 – Hates the saints

Dan. 8:24 – Of the Most high, that is the Jews

2 Thess 2:8 – Destroyed at the Second Coming

Rev. 19:20 – To the Lake of Fire

2. Two Witnesses From Heaven (Church is Gone)

Rev. 11:3-7...

Rev. 11:3 – Prophecy 1260 days

Rev. 11:7 – Finish their testimony (not begin)

Rev. 11:4 – Fulfill prophecy (cf. Zech 4:3,11-14) Therefore, not symbols!

- d) Therefore, the 42 months of Rev. 11:2 must begin the last 3 ½ years of the Tribulation because when Jesus returns Jerusalem will no longer be trodden down by Gentiles
